**Ada Sinz Hill Fellowship** - one full year support (stipend, tuition, health insurance) plus 10% stipend supplement beginning June 1, 2008, to be awarded to an outstanding advanced-year female graduate student. *2008 Awardee - Amanda Morris*

**Zeltmann Fellowship** - one full year support (stipend, tuition, health insurance) plus 10% stipend supplement beginning June 1, 2008, to be awarded to an outstanding advanced-year graduate student. *2008 Awardee - Dan Paull*

**Langmuir-Cresap Research Award** - three months support plus 10% stipend supplement beginning June 1, 2008 plus \$1000 towards research supplies, to be awarded to an outstanding student involved in physical chemistry research. *2008 Awardee - Soren Eustis*
